

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

VA Salt Lake City Health Care System Veterans Transportation Service (VTS), along with the Utah Disabled American Veterans Volunteer Transportation Network (DAV/VTN), partnered to provide expanded transportation services to Veterans with special needs and Veterans who don't have transportation to and from their outpatient appointments.

The new VTS routes will help provide Veterans transportation from Salt Lake and surrounding counties, Idaho Falls, Pocatello, Rock Springs, Afton, Elko, Ely, Logan, Vernal, Price, Richfield and St. George catchment areas to the Salt Lake City VA Medical Center.

QUALIFICATIONS

- ✓ Provide proof of valid and up-to-date auto insurance.
- ✓ Must possess a valid state driver's license and have a clean driving record.
- ✓ Must pass a driver's physical given at the VA upon initial screening and every 4 years thereafter.
- ✓ Attend all driver training and other related skills training as required.
- ✓ Ability to communicate with a variety of people from diverse backgrounds.
- ✓ Accept, understand and respect the confidential aspects of the assignment.
- ✓ Attend volunteer orientation.
