



## **QUALITY OF LIFE**

- Servicemember defined in state code includes guard and reserve members
- Veteran defined in state code after serving 180 cumulative days
- Spouse licensure and reciprocity automatic transferability
- Military Interstate Children's Compact only state to offer FULL protections to the guard and reserve
- Employment Preference in state/local government and private sector hiring expanded to include servicemembers, veterans, and their spouses
- Paid Military Leave Governor approved increasing from 15 to 20 days for executive branch agencies effective January 1, 2025
- Military Support Teams funded therapists and advocates in four school districts
- Military Family Life Consultants funded six LCSW's providing service statewide
- Military and Veteran Family Programs Manager hired Sept 2024
- Suicide Prevention Program Manager hired Aug 2023

## **INSTALLATION RESILIENCY**

- Installation Resiliency Program Manager hired August 2023
- Great Salt Lake Sentinel Landscape awarded June 2024, coordinator hired October
- Camp Williams Sentinel Landscape over \$20+M total resulting in \$80M in projects
- UDVMA approval required land use changes and wind turbines
- Restricted foreign entities banned from owning property
- Military Installation Development Authority (MIDA)




