



Lethal Means Prevention Gun Safe Program

This program provides gun safes to help prevent suicide and accidental harm. Eligibility is based on the following priorities:

Priority 1: A Service Member, Veteran, or Family Member (SMVF) who pledges to secure firearms, ammunition, or harmful medications for an SMVF with mental health needs or who is in crisis.

Priority 2: A SMVF who has someone living at their primary residence who has been identified with mental health concerns and possesses firearms.

Priority 3: Military service members in grades E1-E5 with children living at their primary residence who own handguns but do not have a safe place to secure them.

Before You Receive a Gun Safe

You must complete the following steps to verify your eligibility and coordinate delivery:
